

Directions to get to SSSFA's Garawarra flying field

SUMMARY

It's about 3 km south of Waterfall on the Old Princes Highway, on the western side of the road and ~ 100 m before the Aged Care Facility

DETAILS

1. head south through Heathcote to Waterfall on the Princes H'way
2. Just past Waterfall, the Old Princes H'way branches off to the right and the F6 goes straight ahead. Do NOT go on the F6
3. Take the Old Princes H'way road off to the right. Signs say Garawarra Aged Care Facility and Woronora Dam (or words to that effect)
4. Proceed on for ~3 km. Go past the turnoff (RHS) to Woronora Dam
5. About 400m further on, on the RHS side, are 2 large iron gates. That's the entrance to the flying field.
6. SAFETY WARNING – drive ~100 m past those gates and pull into the road that leads to the Aged Care Facility. This permits you to make a safe U turn and get onto the north-bound lane in order to safely turn into the iron gates.
7. When at those gates:
 - a. Members have a key to the lock. If you are not yet a member then you can only get in if members are already there
 - b. Members fly there Saturdays and Sundays. Sunday morning is probably the most popular time. There could be members flying mid-week but it would be disappointing to go that far and find the gate locked
 - c. Open the right hand gate (it opens towards you); go in and CLOSE it behind you
 - d. Proceed straight ahead, drive slowly and you'll find a car park ~300m in
 - e. Park, walk up the field and start talking to a friendly bunch of people who will be happy to help you with info. or with advice on equipment etc etc
